TUITION OPTIONS

1. **Returning Students**

An enrollment deposit of \$250 is due upon receipt of signed agreement (\$50 during the early re-enrollment period) The remainder of the tuition for the 2018 – 2019 school year should **be paid in full by May 1, 2018** to ensure continuity of the I-20.

2. **New Students**

In the case of a new student the I-20 will be issued upon receipt of the enrollment agreement and a \$1,500 non-refundable deposit. The remainder of the fees will be due prior to the first day of school.

BOARDING STUDENTS

Students are encouraged to book flights into and out of Easterwood Airport in Bryan/ College Station. Pick up and drop off at Easterwood Airport is free. The charge for pick up at Houston International Airport is \$205.

Boarding fees include breakfast and lunch during the school week, **but do not include evening meals or meals at weekends and during school vacations.**

Boarding fees include health insurance for students who register directly with the school and weekly cleaning of the villas.

The boarding facility will be closed during Thanksgiving, Winter, Spring Break and Summer vacations. Parental consent for vacation travel will be required and students must be supervised by an adult over the age of 21.

Participatory Costs:

Class pictures, class trips, field trips, SAT and TOEFL testing, athletic and/or extra-curricular necessities, and other optional services are paid by the family if the family chooses to participate in such programs.
